UNIFORM GUIDELINES

PRIMARY K-6



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Our School uniform unites us as a community. It fosters teamwork and School spirit. The uniform is also an outward sign of self-respect, develops self-regulation and allows our students to benefit from a positive image of our School in the wider community.

Students of Newcastle Grammar School are expected to wear their School uniforms correctly and well.

The new uniform was introduced in 2022 and was designed to be worn year round. The colours chosen include dark blue, white and aqua which represent our physical location.

BLAZERS

Students in Year 3 to Year 6 are required to wear the junior blazer during the winter months as directed by the School.

During this time the blazer must be worn:

- Whilst travelling to and from School as the outermost garment
- To Assembly
- When representing the School

Blazers are compulsory on Speech Day for Years 3-6.

Kindergarten to Year 2 have the option of a soft shell jacket instead of the blazer.

BACKPACK

All students are required to have an NGS Backpack.



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GIRLS UNIFORM OPTIONS K-6

- Dress (length to the knee)
- White blouse with navy crest worn with dark navy shorts
- White blouse with navy crest worn with dark navy trousers
- Tunic with long sleeve white shirt and tie
- Kindergarten have the option of wearing a short sleeve polo with their shorts or trousers (both girls and boys). However, the white shirt with crest must be worn on formal occasions and for School photos
- A long sleeve white blouse with navy crest can also be worn with a tie
- Navy blazer (compulsory Year 3-6 optional K-2)
- Soft shell jacket (optional K-2 in place of blazer)
- Unisex vest, jumper or cardigan (optional)
- NGS scarf and gloves (optional during cooler months)

To be worn with:

- Navy School socks with aqua trim. Navy stockings in winter (optional)
- Black leather school shoes: lace-up or Mary Jane. Velcro is acceptable for K-4.
- School slouch hat (compulsory) or School Panama hat (optional)
- Navy blue hair ribbons or School scrunchie
- Hair elastics: black or hair coloured



GIRLS SPORT UNIFORM K-6

- School House polo (to be worn on PE days and at NGS Carnivals)
- PE sport polo
- PE shorts or PE skort (K-4 only)
- White sport socks (no logo permitted)
- School slouch hat or sport cap
- School swimmers. FINA approved swimsuits may be worn at Carnivals.
- Sport joggers (any colour acceptable, no Converse)
- School Sport Bag (as required)

Optional:

- School tracksuit jacket
- School tracksuit pants
- School rugby jumper or hoodie

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BOYS UNIFORM OPTIONS K-6

- White shirt with navy crest worn with dark navy shorts. Either a long sleeve shirt tucked in with a tie or short sleeve shirt untucked without a tie
- White shirt with navy crest worn with dark navy trousers. Either a long sleeve shirt tucked in with a tie or short sleeve shirt untucked without a tie
- Kindergarten have the option of wearing a short sleeve polo with their shorts or trousers (both girls and boys). However, a white shirt must be worn for formal occasions and for School photos
- Navy blazer (compulsory 3-6 optional K-2)
- Soft shell jacket (optional K-2 in place of blazer)
- Unisex vest, jumper or cardigan (optional)
- NGS scarf and gloves (optional during cooler months)

To be worn with:

- Navy School socks with aqua trim
- Black leather school shoes: lace-up. Velcro is acceptable for K-4
- School slouch hat (compulsory)



BOYS SPORT UNIFORM K-6

- School House polo (to be worn on PE days and at NGS Carnivals)
- PE sport polo
- PE shorts
- White sport socks (no logo permitted)
- School slouch hat or sport cap
- School swimmers. FINA approved swimsuits may be worn at Carnivals.
- Sport joggers (any colour acceptable, no Converse)
- School Sport Bag (as required)

Optional:

- School tracksuit jacket
- School tracksuit pants
- School rugby jumper or hoodie

K-6 may wear their sport/PE uniform to and from school on their allocated sports and PE days.

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HAIRSTYLES - GIRLS

- a conservative style
- a natural colour
- to be tied back with navy ribbons, school scrunchie or hair elastics (black or hair coloured) if long enough to touch the shoulders.
- pulled back from the face (long strands of hair which fall across the face are not acceptable)

HAIRSTYLES - BOYS

- a conservative style ('short back and sides' is the preferred style)
- length must be maintained above the collar
- a natural colour
- long strands of hair that fall across the face are not acceptable
- not to be shaved, nor extremely cut with clippers
- controlled using hair product if necessary

JEWELLERY

Jewellery may not be worn as part of the uniform, with the following exceptions:

- Medic-Alert bracelets or necklaces
- Girls may wear an 8mm single sleeper or plain gold or silver stud earring in the lobe of each ear
- Girls may wear one plain ring

Necklaces (including crucifixes) must not be visible.

Other visible piercings are not permitted whilst at School or School functions when wearing the School uniform.

Jewellery may be confiscated for the duration of the current term should students require frequent reminders.

Boys are not permitted to wear jewellery.

Make-up and nail polish are not permitted.
